What is Integrative Leadership?

Integrative Leadership™ is a wholistic approach to leadership—one that is reflective, conscious, thoughtful and responsive. The process of integration involves developing multiple perspectives, four domains of intelligence (physical, mental, emotional, spiritual) and three levels of awareness (personality, individuality, universality) that, through the power of choice, leads to extraordinary performance; personally, professionally and organizationally, regardless of how that performance is measured. Integrative Leadership is about knowing yourself, being yourself, determining where you are going and what you are here to do which is the path to realizing your potential.

About the Program:

The evening program will introduce the philosophy, principles and practices of the process of integration, discuss the three year human, management and leadership development study whose purpose was to find the life and leadership model that we believed informed all other models, workshop the participants through the Integrative Leadership model (multiple perspectives, four domains, three levels), and share the seven elements that comprise the process of integration.
